





SupplyBank.org developed a pilot program to address diaper need across six counties in Northern California by supplying 100 diapers and 200 wipes on a monthly basis. Three months into the pilot, 472 participants responded to a survey to better gauge the impact subsidized diapers can have on a low income family. 
