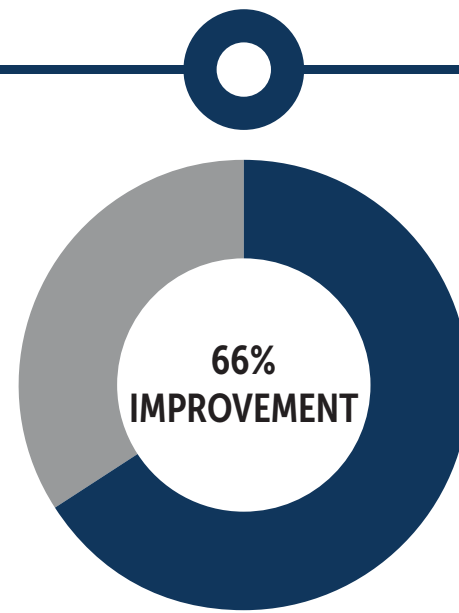

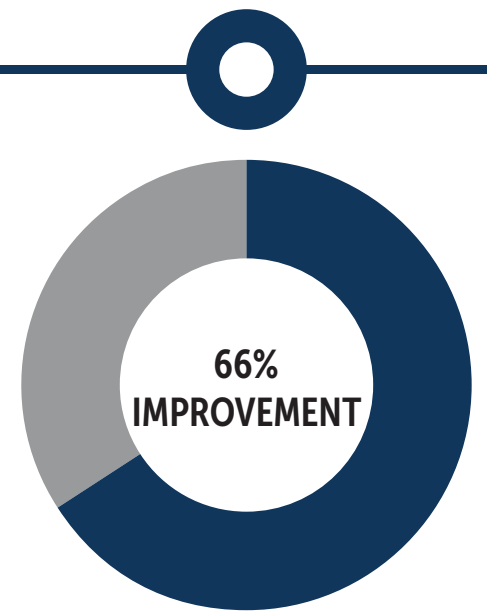
PARENTS' OVERALL CONFIDENCE



PARENTS' STRESS LEVEL

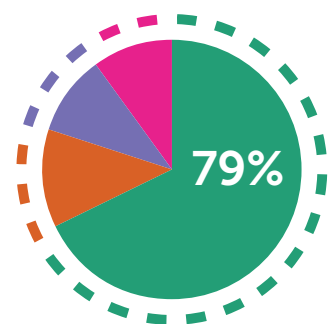

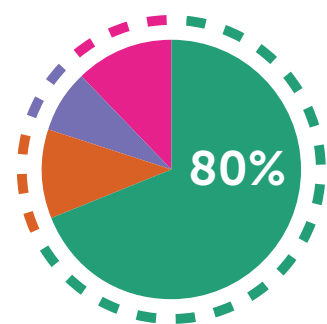

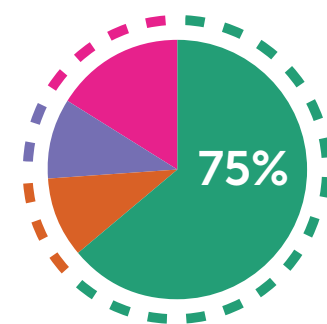
SupplyBank.org developed a pilot program to address diaper need across six counties in Northern California by supplying 100 diapers and 200 wipes on a monthly basis. Three months into the pilot, 472 participants responded to a survey to better gauge the impact subsidized diapers can have on a low income family. Above you will see the impact this program has on a parent's life and below is the impact the program has on the child.

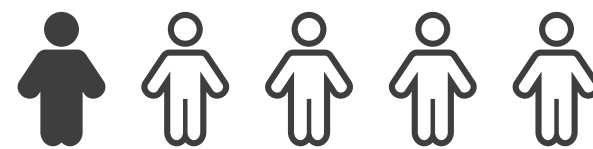
